

Botox Windsor

Botox Windsor - Skin wrinkles are by definition a ridge, crease or fold in the skin. The wrinkles of the skin often appear as a result of aging, including: the prolonged immersion of the skin in water or glycation. The wrinkling of the skin is a result of sun damage, aging, habitual facial expressions, poor hydration, smoking and various other factors. Skin wrinkles in the water because of prolonged water exposure which causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water in the body as with dehydration also can result in the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is one more element that results in degradation of skin collagen.

Dermal fillers are normally utilized to be able to remedy wrinkles and different skin depressions. They are injectable products that are usually a kind of soft tissue. Dermal fillers are designed to enable injection into the skin for reasons of enhancing the skins' appearance. The most popular products are based on hyaluronic acid.

Botulinum Toxin

The Botulinum toxin is a neurotoxin protein which is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. A well-known kind of botulinum toxin is referred to as "Botox," or onabotulinumtoxinA. This particular type of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both cosmetic and therapeutic use. Botox is made use of in the treatment of migraine headache and cervical dystonia or spasmodic torticollis that is a neuromuscular disorder that involves the neck and head. Botox has numerous uses together with its cosmetic application.

A new kind of botulinum toxin became accessible to the American people during the year 2009. This form is called Dysport or abobotulinumtoxinA and is manufactured by Ipsen. It has received FDA approval and is now utilized to be able to remedy cervical dystonia as well as glabellar lines in adults. Botox and Dysport however, are not the same as the molecular structure of the two drugs is different.

The Botulinum toxin can treat a lot of wrinkles by immobilizing or relaxing the muscles that cause wrinkles. This particular toxin is not appropriate for the treatment of all wrinkles, as is seen with glabellar lines, which take place between the eyebrows in adults. Any other usage of this toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not approved by the FDA.
