Injections are normally spaced out over 1 to 2 week intervals, and the majority of treatments do not take any longer than sixty minutes to perform. Depending on the area being treated as well as the complexity and size, the particular number of treatments could range from 4 to 15.

The injection used in a Mesotherapy treatment is targeted on the body, and just require tiny amounts of medications to give noticeable outcome. Another benefit is that patients could avoid many of the side effects which often accompany more dangerous surgically invasive methods or orally administered medications.

Mesotherapy has just become popular in North America. In various areas of the world like for instance South America and Europe, the treatment has been available for a lot of years and has earned a successful reputation. Mesotherapy is made use of primarily as a safe substitute to liposuction, although, it has been efficient also for the cure of arthritis and muscle spasms. There are various clinics which specialize in Mesotherapy for face-lift procedures and several precise jobs like eyelid surgery. These treatments are known as Meso-lifts.

One common side effect of the treatment is bruising. Generally, the bruising would disappear in roughly one week. Arnica Montana, a homeopathic remedy, can be administered, either orally or topically or both on a daily basis to help speed up the process of healing.
